

What is the Plastic Packaging Tax?

This is a new tax which the government are introducing on 1st April 2022. It will apply to plastic packaging manufactured in, or imported into, the UK that does not contain at least 30% Post Consumer, or Pre-consumer Waste recycled material.

The objective of the tax is to stimulate increased recycling activity and collection of plastic waste, diverting it away from landfill and incineration.

How will this affect you?

Below are some answers to the most common questions regarding this tax.

- Who pays the tax to HMRC? The manufacturer or importer of the finished packaging product is responsible to pay the tax.
- How much is the Plastic Packaging Tax? The rate of the tax has been set at £200.00 per metric tonne of plastic packaging which does not contain at least 30% recycled content.
- Which packaging is subject to the tax? The tax applies to all plastic packaging that does not contain at least 30% recycled materials. This includes bioplastics, bio-degradable and compostable plastics.
- How will this affect prices? Inevitably there will be an increase in the cost of some commodities, especially where recycled films are not deemed suitable to be used, i.e., some food and medical products.

- Continue to research and develop new products that reduce the impact on the environment both during manufacture and disposal.
